# HOME SAFETY INSPECTION

A City of Buffalo inspector is coming to **make sure your home is safe** for you to live in.

## WHY ARE THEY COMING?

Buffalo started a new program to inspect rented homes in 2021. We want to make sure you and your family are living in safe, quality housing. We told your landlord that we'll be doing this.





# WHAT ARE THEY LOOKING FOR?

The inspectors are looking for unsafe conditions like chipping paint, leaking water, and broken windows. If they find unsafe conditions, they'll let your landlord know that they need to make repairs.

#### WHAT WILL HAPPEN?

The inspector will meet you at your door at the scheduled time. They'll look around the inside and outside of your home. They will take pictures of things that your landlord needs to fix. The inspection will take 30 min to 1 hour.



## WHAT SHOULD I DO?



- Be on the look out for your inspector about 10 min before they're scheduled to come.
- Show them around your home and point out any unsafe conditions.
- Ask your inspector for their business card. That way, you can call them later if you have questions.
